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MR. V B GADGIL, CE & MD, LTMRHL, INAUGURATES CONSTRUCTION SKILLS DEVELOPMENT CENTRES

Hyderabad 24th August 2012: Mr. V B Gadgil, Chief Executive & Managing Director, L&T Metro Rail (Hyderabad) Limited (LTMRHL) inaugurated the Hyderabad Metro Rail Project - Construction Skills Development Centres (Training Facilities) today at the Uppal Depot and the Uppal Precast Yard. Senior officials from LTMRHL & other L&T group companies also participated in the event.

These training centres will impart focussed short term training to workmen in trades like Formwork, Bar-bending, Pre-casting, Erection, Welding, Scaffolding. Other trades would be added based on the future requirements.

Inaugurating the facility, **Mr. V B Gadgil** stated that "The objective of these training centres is to evaluate and identify skill deficiency/shortfall with the workmen during their induction and provide hands-on training in the respective task and make them deployable onsite. L&T as a part of the Skills Development Initiative and Corporate Social Responsibility is imparting skills training, which contributes to nation building." He added that "LTMRHL is committed in facilitating employment generation and this activity is a step in that direction."

In the training centres, workmen would be trained on the maintenance and usage of right tools, orientation and awareness on the vulnerability of working places, adoption of safe work methodology & discipline, and proper utilization of suitable safety gears.

Details of the Training Facility:

- Hands-on Training Yard with mock ups in a plot of 20 m X 60 m.
- Display hall of 3 m X 15 m with different tools, charts and scale models displayed.
- Sufficient number of tool sets and training materials like formwork systems, re-bar etc.

Approximately 80 workmen will be trained per month from each training centre. Training period will vary from 3 days to 7 days for each task based on respective tasks. 90% of the duration will be on job training. More intensive training for longer period will be arranged in Construction Skills Training Institute (CSTI) Jadcherla where ever found necessary.

Training Method:

- Identification of trade wise task to be trained.
- Preparation of work methodology and sequence of work.
- Pre training assessment of workmen by instructor/demonstrator and identify the skill deficiency.
- Grouping the workmen into gangs of suitable size based on productivity norms for each task.
- Training to understand the instructions/sketches provided and identifying the right materials.
- Hands-on training on the mock ups with close guidance by designated demonstrators following the stipulated work methodology and sequence.
- Intermediate self-assessment of the work done and taking corrective steps before proceeding to next step.
- Final assessment on completion of work and taking corrective steps to match the quality norms.
- Dismantling the work done and redo the same for no.of routines stipulated in the training procedure.
- Post training assessment of the workmen who have under gone training.

Faculty:

- Trained Instructor who is responsible for preparing training procedures and ensuring quality training, pre & post training assessments of workmen.
- Trained Demonstrators who will demonstrate and guide in each step of the task in achieving stipulated parameters.


